**Spring Break:** Spring break for Cadets is 24 Mar – 2 April. The cadets will normally be able to leave after the last military duty (LMD). Prep School Spring Break is 24 Mar (LMD) - 2 April, by 7:00 pm. Cadets should land in Denver not later than 3 hours prior to Academy check-in time at 7:00 pm. No set time for Colorado Springs, but at least an hour is suggested.

**Shuttle Rides to Airports:** For the main breaks from the Academy (Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring Break) the 10<sup>th</sup> Force Support Squadron (10 FSS) Outdoor Recreation Office (719) 333-4602, has shuttle buses (for a cost) that will take the cadets and cadet candidates (Prep School) to Colorado Springs and Denver Airports.

**Cadet Taxes:** Most cadets don't have many deductions and file an EZ form. USAFA has volunteers that can do their taxes for free to ensure they have used all the deductions they are entitled to and are done on an appointment basis. Income Tax assistance will be available through USAFA/JA, located in Harmon Hall, telephone 719-333-3940. If your cadets (C4Cs) need proof of attendance for you to claim part of the year, the cadet needs to go online to USAFA Registrar's website and request a letter. Then the cadet can pick up the letter from the Registrar's Office (Fairchild Hall). See below for more information on Federal Income Tax.



**Jan. 24, 2017**

**COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo.** – After breaking the conference record in the high jump last Saturday, Air Force junior [Shelley Spires](#) was honored with the Mountain West Women's Indoor Field Athlete of the Week award this afternoon (Jan. 24). It is the fifth career award for Spires, who has earned the conference's weekly honor during each of the first three weeks of the current season.

Posting a career-best clearance of 6'1½" to win the high jump at the Air Force Invitational, Spires broke the Mountain West's six-year-old record by a quarter-of-an-inch. The native of Mobile, Ala., improved her own Academy record twice during the series and finalized the run with a one-and-a-half inch personal improvement. Her record-setting clearance, which was achieved on her first attempt, was the second-best jump in the nation over the Jan. 19-21 weekend, while her lead-up clearance of 6'0½" was tied for sixth. Spires, who won the seeded section of the high jump by over an inch and helped Air Force to the team title, is ranked third in the NCAA this season.

With this week's honor, Spires has collected more weekly Mountain West awards (five) than any other member of the women's team in Academy history. Spires, who shared the conference's Jan. 24 award with New Mexico's Josh Kerr (men's track athlete of the week), Colorado State's Mostafa Hassan (men's track athlete of the week) and San Diego State's Micha Auzenne (women's track athlete of the week), returns to action this weekend, when Air Force travels to Albuquerque for the New Mexico Collegiate Invitational on Saturday, Jan. 28.
